SUMMARY

- The Flip Blended Learning methodology is a combination of two teaching models: flipped classroom and blended learning, which, using innovative teaching methods and modern technologies, responds to modern educational challenges, both from the perspective of the student and the lecturer.
- The model reverses the typical lecture and homework components of a course. Students usually watch short video lectures or other multimedia content before they take part in a classroom session.
- In-class time is devoted to active learning such as discussions, project-based or problem-based tasks. This teaching model allows teachers to guide and supervise student learning by answering questions and providing feedback. Traditional homework activities are a part of the face-to-face classroom work with the instructor's support.
