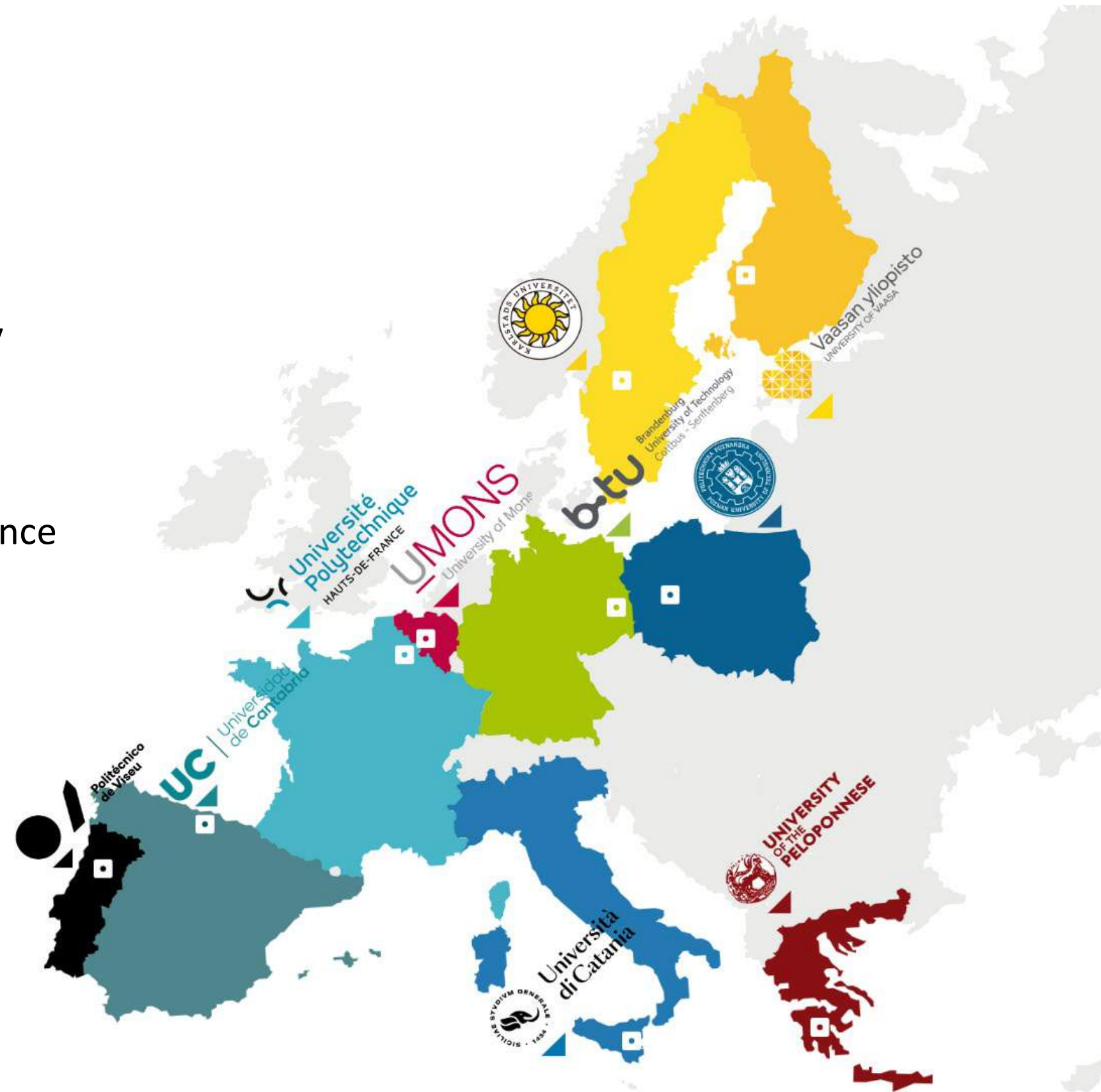

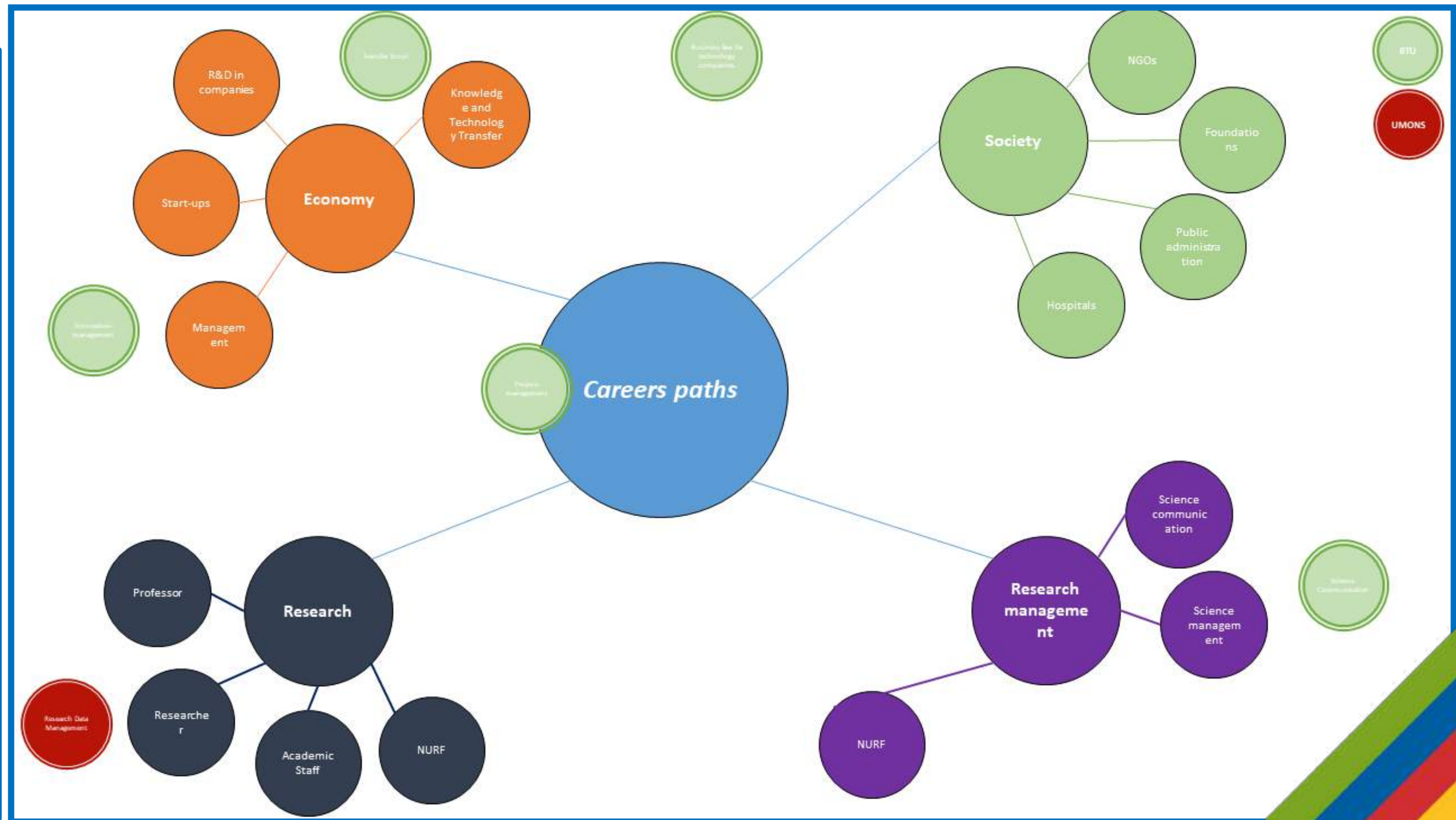



Inclusive Communication Charter

The Charter outlines inclusive communication guidelines, focusing on:

- 1. Language and Terminology:** Promoting inclusive language, gender neutrality, and sensitivity to diverse backgrounds.
 - 2. Clarity and Simplicity:** Ensuring communication is clear and understandable, catering to varying literacy levels and English proficiency.
 - 3. Inclusive Design:** Creating inclusive and accessible communication materials with multiple entry points for user navigation.
 - 4. Digital Accessibility and inclusivity:** Complying with established guidelines for digital content accessibility to ensure that all individuals can interact with online resources.
 - 5. Physical Inclusivity:** Eliminating physical barriers in university spaces and facilitating effective communication through accessible technologies.
 - 6. Representation:** Actively including diverse perspectives and challenging stereotypes in communication campaigns.
 - 7. Respect and Sensitivity:** Fostering a respectful and empathetic environment in all communications.
 - 8. Feedback and Accessibility Support:** Implementing mechanisms for feedback to continuously improve accessibility and responsiveness to user needs.

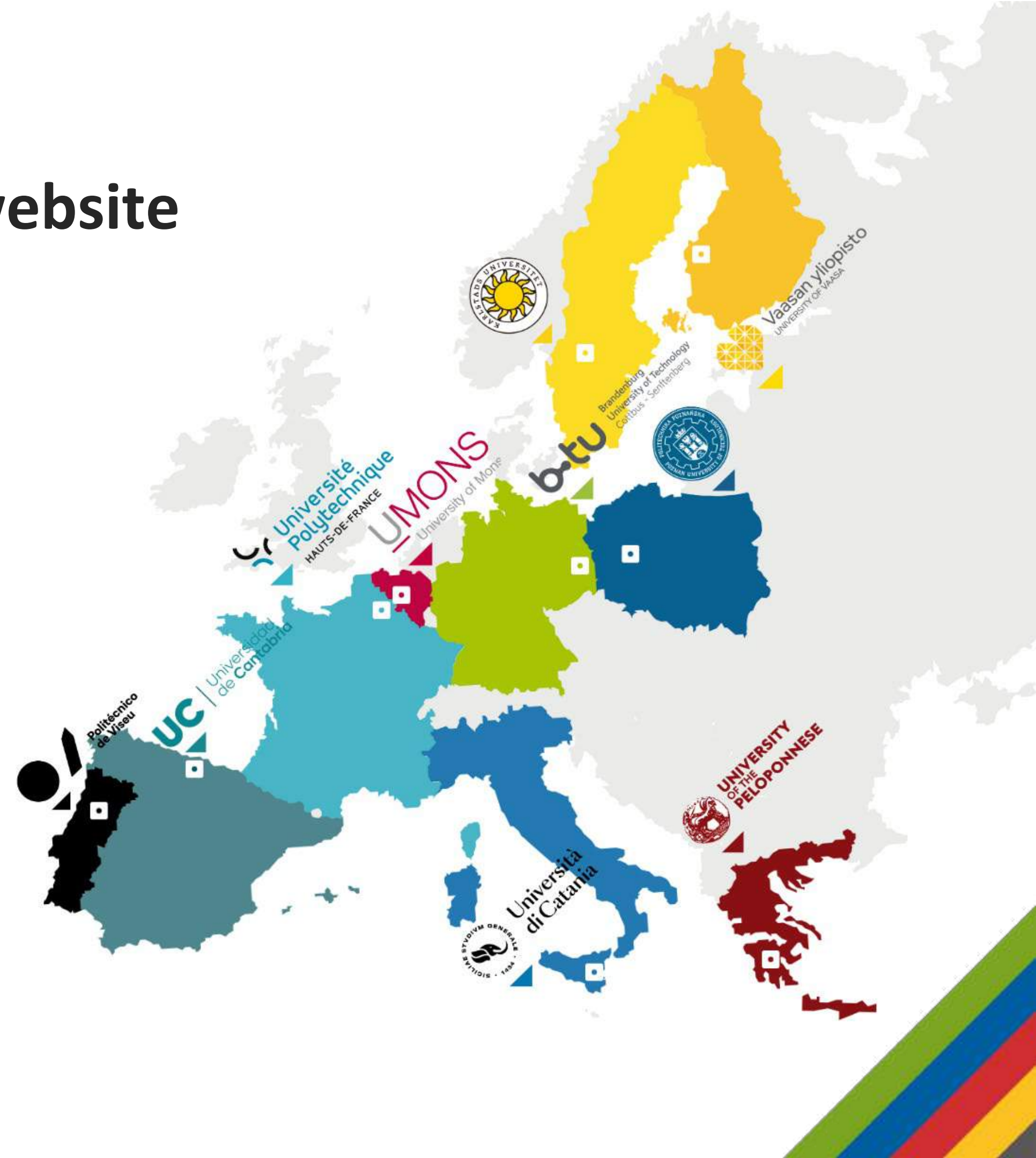
