3. COURSE CONTENT.

he Portuguese A.1.2 course builds on the foundational skills acquired in the A1.1 course, advancing students' ability to communicate effectively in everyday situations. Students will develop a deeper understanding of Portuguese grammar and vocabulary, enabling them to engage in conversations, understand simple texts, and express themselves more confidently in written form. Emphasis will be placed on enhancing cultural awareness, with a focus on exploring the diverse cultures of Portuguese-speaking countries.

4. LEARNING OUTCOMES.

Speaking Skills:

- Engaging in simple conversations about past experiences and future plans
- Asking and answering questions on familiar topics
- Improving pronunciation and intonation

Listening Skills:

- Understanding more complex conversations and instructions
- Recognizing different accents

Reading Skills:

- Comprehending simple texts
- Expanding vocabulary through diverse reading materials

Writing Skills:

- Writing short formal and informal messages
- Using more complex sentence structures

• Understand simple, everyday expressions and basic phrases related to personal information, daily routine, shopping, and immediate surroundings.

Reading Comprehension:

 Recognize and understand familiar words and basic phrases in simple texts, signs, and notices.

Writing Skills:

• Write short, simple messages and personal notes using basic vocabulary and common expressions.

Cultural Awareness:

• Gain basic knowledge of Portuguese-speaking countries' cultures, customs, and traditions.

LEARNING RESOURCES AND TOOLS.

In the A1.2 Portuguese course, tailored resources and tools are provided to support students' language learning journey. Listening and reading materials are carefully selected to match the students' proficiency level, ensuring comprehension and engagement. Worksheets reinforce language skills with content related to everyday scenarios, encouraging autonomous practice. This supportive environment enables students to engage with instructors and peers, enhancing their learning experience and confidence in Portuguese.

PLANNED LEARNING ACTIVITIES AND TEACHING METHODS.

- Role-plays and Presentations: Engage students in interactive role-plays and presentations for contextual language practice.
- Listening Comprehension: Include exercises with audio clips or podcasts for understanding spoken Portuguese.
- Reading Comprehension: Provide texts for comprehension practice and discussion.
- Self-Reflection Quizzes: Offer quizzes to assess understanding and track progress.
- Group Work: Facilitate collaborative activities for communication and problem-solving.

7. ASSESSMENT METHODS, CRITERIA AND PERIOD.

In the Portuguese A1.2 course, students will be assessed through a range of synchronous and asynchronous tasks spanning four units. Assessment techniques will include quizzes, participation in discussion activities, and creation of multimedia presentations. Evaluation criteria will focus on students' grasp and usage of basic Portuguese vocabulary, comprehension of fundamental concepts related to the topics covered, and their ability to apply language skills in practical contexts. The assessment schedule will be distributed throughout the course, ensuring continuous monitoring of student progress and providing timely feedback.
