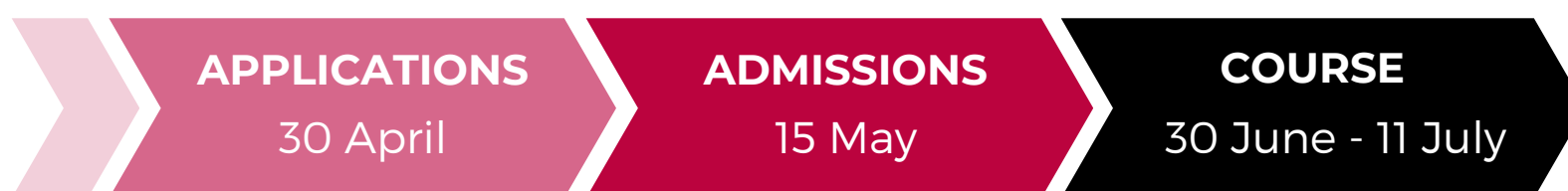
## **CROSSING BORDERS: COLONIAL ECHOES IN LANGUAGE, SPACE AND CULTURE**
