EUNICE Agrees to Welcome a Brazilian University as a New External Collaborator

At its latest General Assembly, hosted by the University of Peloponnese (Greece), EUNICE agreed to welcome Federal University of Viçosa (Brazil) as an external associated partner, and thus increase the number of non-EU collaborators. The meetings also advanced work on project management, academic programmes, research collaboration, cultural initiatives, and approved the Joint Open Lab Memorandum of Agreement, which will help unify equipment and infrastructure access across all EUNICE universities.
